MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - February 9th, 1987

Items discussed -

- 1) Case #2 discussed. Town will help with rent, electricity, but not telephone. (EXECUTIVE SESSION)
- 2) Stephen DiBiaso at meeting in regard to Planning Board. He has talked with Madge Baker of ^{So. Maine Planning} Me. Municipal regarding the problems they are having. Code Enforcement Officer feels that he does not get enough input and he has resigned. Seems there is a lack of communication between the Selectmen and Planning Board.
 - a) Terms of appointment were set by State Legislature. Planning Board was adopted because of the Wetland areas. Five persons on Board with two alternates. The enforcement is up to the Selectmen and the two Boards should work together. If the town grows, it should be controlled growth. Nothing for the town to vote on at Town Meeting. Trailer Ordinance to be in Town Report. A letter was sent last meeting to Wilfred Taylor suggesting that the Planning Board meet on different night than Selectmen, so they can attend the meetings. Public Hearings should be told to Selectmen. Planning Board would like to meet with Selectmen, March 9th at 7 P.M.
- 3) Craig Kingsley has resigned. Motion made to put an Ad in Shopping Guide. VOTE.
- 4) Town Report: Bids submitted: Seavey Printers \$866.68 500 copies and 56 pages. T. Hosmer: \$1160 for 500 copies and 56 pages. Contract awarded to Seavey Printers. Copy must be done February 23rd. March 9th delivery date.
- 5) Letter read from Cornish Water Co. stating they had met with Howard and had problems with communication between the parties. Paul Frinsco will contact them so the Cornish Water Co. purchase can be made. Jim is concerned about the purchase of stock in the Water Co. T. Hosmer suggested that the Trustees go to the P.U.C. and check on the records of the Water Co. for a copy of equipment.
- 6) Richard Taylor Tax Abatement: Letter from Commissioners asking for a delay until weather conditions are better for viewing.
- 7) Rodney Stacy has taken care of the ice backed up on Town Hall.
- 8) Eva Lord Property: Warranty Deed has been drawn up by Bud Runyon for Mr. Hall.
- 9) Motion made: To ask John Hoyt be asked to be Moderator for Town Meeting. VOTE
- 10) Bill for Cornish Lumber Co. \$103.94 - Freddie needs a box to put dogs in to transport them to Bridgton.

- 11) Flags for Memorial Day - Bonnie will take care of this and talk with Don Jack.
- 12) Bonnie stated that the road narrows down by Hardware Store and asked if it wasn't Franklin Sanborn's job to haul it away? It was decided to wait until another storm.
- 12) Bill from Chas. Whitney \$75.00 for plowing at the dump.
- 13) Jim reported on Dump progress - survey will be done and finished by air, so it won't need to be plowed again. Stephen is checking on deed to the dump at Alfred. BFI drew up contract. If Normantus closes over night, BFI can set something up in two days.
- 14) Thomas Hosmer would like to have a Agenda of Selectmen's Meetings posted. Warren opposed to haveing this done on the Meetings.
- 15) Thomas Hosmer also would like a copy of Selectmen's Minutes posted in Town Hall. Motion made to post minutes of Selectmen's and Planning Board Meetings in Town Hall. VOTE.
