MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - March 10, 1986

- 1) Charter: Don checked with Secretary of State and he got a copy of the original Charter dating back to 1794 when Maine was still part of Mass. He is waiting to hear from Maine Municipal .
- 2) Don will work a transition period - a month or so - with newly elected Selectman.
- 3) Cornish Water Bill: Hearing has been had - no problems. Charlene to check and verify vote. It should be signed by April 1st. Federal Revenue Sharing may not be able to help until October. Maine Bond Bank money is at 7% - 20 years.
- 4) Town Reports are ready.
- 5) Town poor: Should notify the State that someone else is taking over.
- 6) Solid Waste: Baldwin raised \$26,000.
- 7) Lloyd Sargent gave the Town the Boston Post Gold Handle Cane. Eva Wing is now the oldest resident of Cornish.
- 8) No smoking signs are posted in the Hall.
- 9) Bid for new contract for plowing & sanding.
- 10) Town Meeting, March 17th at 2 P.M.
