WILL HAVE TO SIGN THE LETTER.


5. PHIL LOVEJOY-INSURANCE:

1. PIKE HALL-CONTENTS UP TO 50,000
2. APT., STABLE, SHED UP TO 50,000
3. GRANDSTAND UP TO 75,000
4. SAND AND SALT SHED UP TO 75,000
5. SEWER UP TO 10,000

MR. LOVEJOY WILL SEND OVER SOME REVISED FIGURES.
THE TENANT PROVIDES THE INSURANCE FOR THE BUILDING.
HELI MODIFIED-LIABILITY IS AUTOMATIC
MONTHS BUILDERS RISK ON MARCH 1 TO SEPTEMBER 1, 1999
