

Regular meeting March 29th - all members present
Voted to grant the request of John Prince that
business conducted at Selectmen's meetings be pub-
lished in the Shopping Guide on a trial basis.

Two representatives of the CETA program, Davis
Clark of Augusta and Sue Beckwith of Sanford, were
present and explained the program and how it could
apply to the town.

Voted to have the broken windows in the Town Hall
replaced.

Voted to table the selection of a committee for
renovation of the basement of the Town Hall (Article
43 of the Town Meeting Warrant) until more information
is available. Anyone interested in serving on this
committee is requested to contact the Selectmen.
Appointment of Building Inspector, member of the
Conservation Committee and of the Planning Board tabled
until the next meeting.
