

Selectmen's Meeting March 6, 2013

Vinal Pendexter, Nancy Perkins and Daniel Sherman were present for the meeting.

AGENDA: Maurice Ouellette, York County Sheriff

Sheriff provided details of a recent change in patrolling between the State Police and York County Sheriff's department. State Police are responsible for 5 towns; Lebanon, Alfred, Dayton, Lyman, and Hollis. Sheriff department is responsible for 9 towns; contracted towns of Arundel, Acton/Shapleigh, Waterboro, Parsonsfield, and Limington along with Cornish, Limerick, and Newfield.

The State Police in Gray has handled our Dispatching since 2009. Selectmen asked if it would remain there. Sheriff stated 90% is now through Sanford. Selectmen reiterated the topography issues identified by Mark Greene of York County (see attachment). Sheriff reports he has equipment on Fort Ridge, Blueberry Mountain, Mt. Hope in Sanford, and Hosac Mountain (no equipment on Ossipee Mountain) and it does the job for him.

The fire chief and assistant chief will be asked about the ramifications of the dispatching from the State Police in Gray to Sanford.

Warrants and Minutes reviewed and signed.

Quit Claim Deed covering years '09 and '10 real estate taxes for Southridge Development Corporation (R02-006) presented for signature. Motion made to sign the Quit Claim Deed. Seconded and approved.

10 copies of the 2013 Town Warrant signed by selectmen.

C N Brown's credit program changed from a 2-part slip requiring a signature to a card that is swiped. The Fire Department and Snow Plowing contractor to determine the number of cards they'll want issued.


Motion made to sign the MDOT Agreement to allow heavy loads on town roads in anticipation of the Route 25 paving project. Seconded and approved.
