

SELECTMEN'S MEETING APRIL 16, 2003

John from Pine Tree Waste came in to discuss the trash situation. He claims that he equals out weight that gets put under Cornish's tipping fees. He has 15 accounts in Cornish that he picks up. He also stated that people from away stop and dump their trash in open dumpsters, and that the containers are left open and get filled with ice and snow. Several solutions were discussed such as: have commercial accounts pay their own fees, or having Jordan's put a cap on prices in the next contract. Vinal will talk to Geneva and Diane about attending a meeting to discuss solutions.



Peggi reported on what had happened at the meeting with Margo Frasier. The fence at Thompson Park should be up by Memorial Week-end. She also understood that the grant money would cover snow removal costs for the first two years. CAB had mentioned that local snow-plowers had been pushing snow into the park. Signs can be posted but they are basically unenforceable and that CAB should be notified that they should watch so they can be stopped. Heli modified had also been discussed. Peggi has the name and number for them to contact the small business development center so they can get an extension for the employment clause. Carol will call them Friday with the number. Margo had also said that the town should pay for a taller pole with the rent money. Vinal said that the rent money is to cover the loss of taxes and that the owner of the pole should replace it. The Cab people had also mentioned that they want to move the Apple Festival to the fairgrounds.


Vinal asked if the bill for dispatch had come in. Scott had told him that it had gone up and that no more than \$8000.00 should be paid.


