

MINUTS TO SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
APRIL 19, 1993

1. Meeting called to order at 7:20 pm.

Forest Rangers - Bruce Small and Mark came in to discuss the house on Rt 5 the Selectmen have some concerns with renting, the proposed lease is year to year with a 30 day out, must pay your own insurance. If the forestry moves out Bruce doesn't see much effect if any. If the Forestry has no more use for the property it goes back to the donator for first option, they are checking into the title deed but do not see any problems with having clear title. In order for the Forestry to dispose of any property they first must offer it to other State agencies, then Municipalities and then it would go out to bid. At this time the Forestry still has interest in the property for storage of their equipment. The town could rent the building and winterise it to keep their options open. Cornish is interested in a more permanent agreement, for maybe a salt shed or expansion of the Fire Dept. ect. Selectmen proposed to purchase the property and rent it back to the Forestry Dept. Bruce feels that the Selectmen should draft a proposal to the Forest Dept. with different options on it .
