

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING**  
**APRIL 2, 2003**

The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrant were signed.

There was a discussion about the sidewalks. Vinal has talked to Bobby Sturgeon about snow removal. He will research costs. The sidewalks also need to be swept. The state has always done this in the past, but they are passing the costs to the town. Vinal will get in touch with Tom at the MDOT office in Standish to find out more information. Peggi suggested that an ad be put in the Shopping Guide that property owners care for the sidewalks that border their land. Peggi made a motion to table the discussion until the next meeting. John seconded the motion.

There was a discussion on the trash situation. Out of town trash was being hauled in and put under Cornish's tipping fees. Trash hauling for commercial waste has been halted. The contract with Jordan's Trucking has to be checked on for the expiration date, so it can be put out to bid. Peggi suggested that letters be sent to business asking that they recycle their cardboard. Vinal will call MMA to ask about legal ramifications of having only contracted haulers. Diane is going to call and get the advertised hours for recycling out of the Shopping Guide.

It was decided that Carol would get a \$2.00 an hour raise instead of Agent fees, since Agent fees would be taken away when Diane is Agent. Diane refused the raise in pay for Treasurer.


