- 3) Rescue Unit is discussing a Central Dispatch system \$90,000. The Fire Dept. and Rescue Unit are having trouble getting coverage for dispatching. This is the same in all towns.
- 4) Gordon Day says Lane's haven't picked up any rubbish this winter and they have been billed and paid each month. Gordon, with much urging, will take rubbish to dump for \$15.00 per month.

- 7) Charlene is to move Town Clerk's Office to Town Hall. Hours to be posted. Shopping Guide to be notified.
