- 2) Davis Matter: The State Health Officer advises that it is a costly and drawn out procedure to declare their house unliveable. If the Town condemns the house, the Town must provide housing for the family. David will go down and talk with them and explain that they are in violation of the public nuisance law.
- 3) Mrs. Collomy has complained about Beverly & Ezmund Day.
- 4) Paul Gorsky: Re Rose Perkins House. His attorney has records going back years and Town voted in 1927 to close the road. Charlene is checking to see what papers they have and what they say.
- 5) William Keith: Motion to issue gun permit - Seconded. VOTE.
- 6) Tree between Tarbox and Hartfords. Needs to come down. Ronnie to check.
- 6) Lillian Sturgeon wants no parking signs put up. No parking in road-way on road. Motion: No sign be put up. Seconded. VOTE.
- 7) Dump: Bill to Sacopee Solid Waste in May. See if Normantus will stay open another month. Merck is to be open 6-1-87.
- 8) Lloyd Sargent will replace light switches.
