

Selectmen's Meeting April 3, 2013

Vinal Pendexter and Daniel Sherman were present. Nancy participated by telephone conference.

Suzanne Day asked to use the fire station April 24th for a meeting relating to Maine's "Literacy for ME" initiative. Motion made to allow Suzanne to use the fire station. Seconded and Approved.

Motion made to nominate Margaret Aspinall and Emily Lyle Ward to the Sacopee Rescue Board of Directors. Seconded and approved.

Vinal Pendexter signed the letter to Mike Edgecomb of Time Warner Cable to officially notify him of deficiencies in the current contract requiring action on their part.

Selectmen designated Diane (in her position as Town Clerk) the town's Public Access Officer. MMA's Membership Database Clerk will be notified.

Town of Cornish Maine School Administrative District #55 Referendum Warrant and Notice of Election to be posted were signed by selectmen.

York County Taxes decreased \$3000 for FY2013.

Selectmen discussed the next steps the Pike Hall Committee will take for the drainage repair.

A selectmen's workshop was scheduled for Wednesday, April 10th at 6:30 pm. Topics include: Delinquent R/E taxes on properties, set a date and time to assess the status of building permits for 2013 R/E taxes, a course of action for the Pike Hall Committee, and 2012 unresolved issues still requiring action.

The status of Cornish Historical Society acquiring Liability Insurance was reviewed in light of fundraising events scheduled.

The town will investigate MSAD#55 plans to go out to bid for #2 heating fuel and ask to participate with them.

Time Warner emailed notification they will not be able to compile the information needed for the Connect ME grant application by the April 15th deadline. Selectmen plan to focus on the second deadline for applications this Fall. Pat Junkins will supply the majority of the information required and Vinal and Dan will work on preparing a density survey of roads not serviced by Time Warner. Dan Sherman will talk to Pat Junkins to relay Time Warner's notification to us.
