APRIL 30, 2003

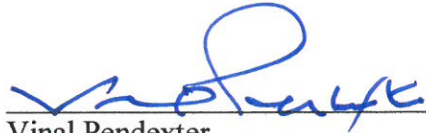
The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable warrant and the payroll warrant were signed.

Geneva Jordan and Diane Day came in to discuss the trash situation. Their contract expires May 31, 2003. Vinal made a motion to pick up the 1-year option and put it up for bid in 2004. John seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. It was also decided that a rate fee cap would be put in the contract.

The water district rate increase was discussed. Vinal had found out that the PUC had to be asked to check rate increases. John made a motion that the PUC be asked to check on the increase. Peggi seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Vinal will call the PUC.

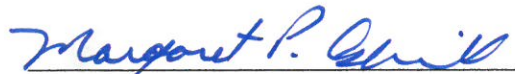

New England Tool had sent in a quitclaim deed to be signed. There is a lien on the property. There had been a double payment on personal property received in 2000. It had never been applied to the real estate taxes. Vinal made a motion that abatement be made for the interest that had accrued since that time. John had seconded the motion. The quitclaim was signed by the selectmen. Diane will get it notarized and Peggi will deliver it in the morning so they can get refinanced.
