MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - April 6, 1987

Present: Warren Neal; Ronald Othuse; Bonita Ouellette

1) \$30,000 Grant for Septic System for village <sup>wn 8/10/88</sup> received from DEP Engineer will be in town April 28th at 7 P.M. for the Selectmen to go with him to assess if this money is enough to do the project.

2) Audit request granted and will notify us of date.

3) Flood Damage: Soil Conservation office has funds available.

4) Keys to Hall: Three Selectmen, Charlene and Joan. Motion made: to put extra set of keys under lock and key. Seconded VOTE.

5) Recommendations of Audit. Daily deposits. The Selectmen recommend that each days receipts to be tallied separately and deposited the next business day. All other recommendations per Auditor and we are aware of them.

6) Jim Smith issued permit to Jim Seelye. Warren asked for a stop work order. Paul Frinsco contacted re letter written with 10 conditions spelt out. One condition not done was that of having an architect draw up plans for his building before constructing. Public meeting will give Selectmen footage and clear the way for enforcement. 7) Special Town Meeting: Trailer Ordinance.

9) Code Enforcement Officer: Three applied, Michael Cox; Elmer Macdonald and David Birchfield. David Birchfield was appointed unanimously. Mr. Smith notified by letter 4/7.

10) Mr. Taylor called Bonnie again re sanding contract. She advised him again of the time of meeting and that he should come and talk with Selectmen. Mr. Taylor did not arrive.

11) Freddie Hayes: No information from State Police. Before his Gun Permit can be denied, it must be sure that all is legal.
