

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - APRIL 8, 1991

PRESENT: W. NEAL, V. PENDEXTER, C. CANDAGE

1. CLIFTON WHITNEY HERE BECAUSE OF INCREASE IN TAXES.

2. LEONA CHASSE HERE REGARDING PARK: TONY EASTMAN'S 5TH GRADE CLASS HAS SOLD SCHOOL SUPPLIES AT SCHOOL AND NOW WISH TO USE PROFITS OF \$150.00 IN DOING SOMETHING IN THE PARK. THEY WILL DEPOSIT THIS MONEY IN THE TOWN ACCOUNT. THEY WOULD TO REPLACE THE CHRISTMAS TREE, FOR ALL TO ENJOY. SELECTMEN SUGGESTED ALSO OBTAINING A PLACQUE. NO OBJECTIONS FROM SELECTMEN.
