

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MAY 1, 2002**

The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrants were signed.

Vinal couldn't reach David Sawyer so he didn't make it to this meeting.

There was discussion about Mr. Wishart's real estate tax. Mr. Wishart's lawyer called and wanted to negotiate on the back tax amount. He doesn't owe that much so it was decided, in order to not set precedence, that it is nonnegotiable.

Also discussed was the need to correct the setback ordinance. The ordinance says the setbacks measurements should start from the middle of the road instead of the edge of the right of way.

A special Town Meeting needs to be called before the 15th of May. The article 24 was amended to \$1000.00 and it needs to be worded to include the correct costs, and adjusted to five crosswalks instead of three.

There was a discussion on the need to build a new Municipal Building. It will include a meeting place, a fire garage, and the town offices.

Vinal received a call from Jill Humphrey about the relocation of the recycling box being put across from her house. It was decided that that wasn't a very good place for it and have decided to put it up at the sand/salt shed. That way it is already fenced in.

There was also a discussion on the front walkway at Pike Hall. It was thought a better idea was to rip out the old concrete and put down a walkway the same as the new crosswalks will be. That will get rid of the salt on the concrete problem. Carlton will call to get the prices. This can also be discussed at the special town meeting.
