

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - May 11, 1987

Present: Warren Neal, Bonita Ouellette, Ronald Othuse

1) Marilyn McCulloch attended meeting - wanted her term on Planning Board defined. Minutes of 2-23-87 meeting indicate as follows: "Motion made and seconded that the following members be appointed to the Planning Board for a three year term: Marilyn McCulloch; Thomas Hosmer; Mary Picchi; Jack Kelley, Alternate.

Marilyn asked that if the Board of Selectmen would appoint her to a five year term. Motion made that request be taken under advisement.

2) Hearing on Friday re Dump. ronnie will answer any questions.

3) Paul Gorsky - closing road on Trafton Street. It was voted on March 25, 1927 (Town Meeting) not to make a town road there. Motion made that the Paul Gorsky road matter be closed. Letter written to Mr. Gorsky to that effect.

4) Planning Board: Thomas Hosmer resigned from Board. Joe Kendal resigned 4-27-87. Two appointments to be made. Vinal Pendexter and Walter Stickney recommended by the Board of Selectmen. Motion made that Vinal Pendexter and Walter Stickney be appointed to the Planning Board, SEconded. VOTE. This is for a three year term effective May 11, 1987.

5) Beverly & Ezmund Day matter: Motion made that Bonnie Ouelette talk with District Attorney in the above matter. (Copy of file for Bonnie)

6) Taylor abatement set for Monday at 6:30 p.m., May 18th with the County Commissioners.

7) Tree at Tarbox/Hartford property. Tree is not dead. It is dangerous and should come down, perhaps not this year, but next. Right on property line. Danny Day removed other trees for Town Warren to contact him.

8) Water Co.: Temporary Financing. PUC hasn't acted on the matter. Approved by Maine Bond Bank. Funds available 5-20.

9) York County Regional Planning Board - two representatives from each town, one of which is an elected official. They recommend replacing H. Sheperdson as Don Jack is Vice President of Commission. Bonnie Ouellette will serve.

10) Saco river Corridor Commission write to advise Rules Committee in regard to Transfer Station. It is prohibited. People are using the old dump. Cannot rope it off as it is the entrance to property owned by Robinson Mfg. Co. Town of Hiram wants to go around SRCC. Ronnie feels we should find another site.

11) Sewer. David has list of people on system.

12) Taxes: Rest of transfers need to be done. Visit property.

13) Memorial Day Parade: Start at Post Office and march to cemetery.

14) Motion made: Repair Lawnmower. Seconded. VOTE.

15) Meeting adjourned.
