- II. Dump Meeting next Thrsday at 1:00 P.M. (5/15/80) with DEP and the Selectmen of the five towns. This replaces the meeting previously arranged in Augusta.
- III. Phil Day came to discuss sidewalk work--he can start anytime now. F.R. Carroll to do cement work--Marcia to call and see about an estimate.
- IV. Robert Dougherty willing to serve on Appeals Board
- V. Norton House--suggestion was made to place some of the responsibility to improve conditions of house onto its owner, Mr. Van-Watt. Also report of an open sewer pipe into cellar--Bill to draw up a letter to go out.
- VI. Donnie Metcalf notified by Willie Liberty, Building Inspector, to hurry up and finish cleaning up burnt building next door. Code states that 1 year is given to demolish, so Don is already way over limit.
- VII. Cathy Chaiklin heading up tree program in Kezar Falls. Bill is going to speak to P. Fenderson. He will also speak to park Commission to get going in the Park.
- VIII. Sludge Disposal Site: Bob Sawyer's. Bill to speak to Jack Murphy to get a soils test.
- IX. Bill to come up with letter to new members of Planning Board and Appeals Board. Doc spoke to Marilyn Pelletier and she is willing to serve as alternate.
- X. Phil Day/ Dep't. of Transportation: Kimball Hill improvements to come out of TRI money. Raised question of whether we need to get town approval to authorize work.
