To review the applications of Susy Owens (The Carriage Inn) and George and Judy Moneyhun (Cornish Country Inn) for liquor licenses.

The following points were raised in regards to the Owens' application:

1. on what and how many levels will liquor be served?
2. amount of footage to the church (there is a 300' minimum necessary). The Owens have spoken with the church. John Palmer verified the church's willingness to cooperate.
3. parking capacity?
4. sewage?
5. Address - Main or Bridge - because of main entrance being on back (Bridge) and regarding #2. The Owens choose to use Main Street address because the front of the building is on Main Street.
6. Application under Susy's name only - ad was stated under both Tom and Susy.

The following points were raised in regards to the Moneyhun's application:

1. there will be no bar
2. with meal only
3. 210' to church entrance from the Inn's main entrance. Had not spoken to anyone from the church.
4. question raised regarding separate application for entertainment
