MAY 15, 2002

They will write an article for the next town meeting and also include that the monies appropriated for the cemeteries be put in a perpetual account.

A proposal was received from Call Enterprises for the Town Office to be moved into their new building. Since the selectmen have started to look into building a municipal complex this proposal shall be filed.






Vinal stopped at David Brandt's office and gave him all the information on Merc so he can look into the situation and let the Selectmen know what he thinks they should do.
