


TOWN OF CORNISH
MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MAY 20TH, 1998

PRESENT: CARLTON CANDAGE, WILLIAM PEASE & VINAL PENDEXTER

- 1.) Chairperson (Carlton Candage) calls the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.
- 2.) Minutes of May 6th reviewed and accepted. Warrant read and signed.
- 3.) a. CEO (Ray Estabrook) advises the Selectmen that the current estimate for Town Offices is \$16,225. Ray is still waiting for estimate figures from Lloyd Sargent.
b. Selectman states he is dissatisfied with the change in plans and wants the work to start as originally discussed placing Town Offices in basement kitchen. Discussion followed.
- 4.) Jim Campbell comes before the Selectmen as a candidate for the York County Commissioner. Selectmen ask him to march in August parade.
- 5.) a. Ronald Othuse (CFD Chief) requests information regarding RT.5 forestry buildings.
b. Mr. Othuse asks about the FEMA funds that were discussed at prior meeting. Decision to keep funds in present account. Possibility for Fire Dept. to use to purchase of new jackets.
c. Mr. Othuse announces the Communications Tower now has power.
d. Mr. Othuse also discusses upgrade of hose to larger hose in near future.
e. William Pease asks CFD to soak shrubs in Business Park.
- 6.) Carlton Candage asks Vinal Pendexter to speak with Dennis Mowry about this years Audit.
- 7.) Carlton Candage makes motion to go into Executive Session. Motion seconded by Vinal Pendexter. All in favor.
- 8.) Motion made to exit Executive Session. Motion seconded. All in favor.
- 9.) Selectmen ask that Town Clerk notify the Police Dept. about the recent items missing from Town Hall and call Insurance Co. to see about deductibles/coverage.

- 10.) Motion made to accept Greg Wilfert to the Southern Maine Regional Planning Committee. Motion seconded. All in favor.
- 11.) Motion made to accept Chris Birchfield as Chairperson for the Planning Board, Woodrow Hartford for another term and Bob Delesandro as an alternate. Motion seconded. All in favor.
- 12.) Board of Appeals vote will be held at next Selectmen's meeting.
- 13.) Selectmen ask for notification each Friday of upcoming weeks meetings and events.
- 14.) Carlton is still waiting for a response to his inquiry with Zebra striping about the painting of crosswalks to be done downtown.
- 15.) Vinal Pendexter asks that Christmas lighting in park be removed and that the grass be reseeded in abused area.
- 16.) Elwyn Day's bill from ICE STORM 98 will be resubmitted.
- 17.) Motion made to adjourn. Motion seconded. Adjourned 8:20 PM




