

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
MAY 28, 2003**

The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrant were signed.

Diane asked if the fee for the town hall could be waived for the Richie Aaron benefit. Vinal made a motion that the fee be waived. John seconded the motion.

A letter was received from the York County commissioners. They are forming an ad hoc committee to establish a Charter commission for York County; they are looking for a member and an alternate from each town.

Heli modified sent in a letter about the pole replacement situation. They are going to have it run in and then go underground. Vinal will stop to see them and find out if fixing the road is included in the cost.


Bob Mesereau came in to get names for alternate positions open on the fairgrounds committee. Carlton Candage, Greg Wilfret, Pam Miller, and Robert Motes all had expressed an interest on being on this committee. Bob will invite them to a meeting to see if they still want to join. He also asked about a public hearing to change the wording on an article on the fairgrounds bylaws. Vinal said that a public hearing had to be scheduled for the new fire barn's location. A Special Town Meeting will be called to vote on the bids for the fire barn and the fairground changes.

Rob Millard and Roland Scott came in to discuss the consent agreement that was written up about his "junk-yard". Roland wanted to show it to a lawyer before signing. He is going to do that and get back to us. He also said that he would be applying for a junkyard permit. He wants to move it from Rt 5 to a field that can't be seen.

Rob was also informed about the creation of an illegal lot. He will have to get in touch with the Leonharts and let them know they will have to transfer more land over to Michael Hutton so he will have the legal lot size of 3 acres. Rob suggested that when the ordinance books were updated that not allowing more than one house per lot would fix any future problems of this kind.

John said that Ethel Sargent had talked to him about an unexpected oil bill that she had received and wanted the town to pay for it. John was given the YCCA telephone number to pass on to her, so she could get in touch with them about paying it.

Vinal made a motion to adjourn the meeting. John seconded the motion.
