Notice received from D.O.T. on a project involving Limington and Cornish - East of the West Junction of Star 117.


Received letter from Robert Harrisburg's Attorney, regarding site review on Co-Hi property.


Discussion on a call that Vinal Pendexter received from Laurie Carr, regarding mobile home going in next to her.


Mike Hartford was to attend meeting to discuss Rescue Unit members being low-Vinal had previously spoken to Mike about billing insurance companies for their services.
