Sacopec Valley House of Pizza and Thompson Park Grill had both submitted Liquor License applications. These were both signed.


Vinal hasn't been able to get in touch with David Brant about Picinni's gates on the Old Town Road.


Carlton will talk to Elwin Day again about getting the leftover salt moved inside.


