

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - June 1, 1992

Present: Vinal Pendexter, Carlton Candage, Donald Jack

1. Meeting called to order by Chairman Pendexter at 7:15 p.m.
2. Vinal contacted Bruce Smith in regard to his letter about
  1. Stumps being dumped behind Scott Campbell's house.
  2. Discarded appliances and animals over the bank behind Post Office.
  3. Reid Crossman' swimming pool.
  4. Video Venture deadline for having their parking lot up to regulations. (Deadline is July)
3. Farmers Market: There is a concern about Wedding receptions being held on Saturdays when there is a Farmers Market. People running market are gone by noon. Vinal will talk with Chris Birchfield before June 6th to find out just what she wants. Stan Thompson wrote regarding the parking lot and his lawyer told him that the Bag Lady does have complete control of parking lot. There are no agreements in writing and there is none in the lease. Bag Lady's lease has been renewed from 8-92 through 8-93. Don suggested Walter Rines be contacted and see if he can remember any agreements being made.
4. Mickey Pingree here regarding signatures needed of the Selectmen on a Mutual-Aid Agreement between the five towns. Five copies signed by the Selectmen.
5. Wendy Nason interviewed for Deputy Clerk and Bookkeeper/Secretary position. MOTION MADE AND SECONDED TO APPOINT WENDY NASON AS DEPUTY CLERK AND BOOKKEEPER/SECRETARY FOR THE TOWN OF CORNISH. Charlene Humphrey was also included in the vote. Vote 4-0.
6. Cash Situation: Balance \$12,000 ± Holding School check. Taxes should go out around July 1st.
7. Charlene has asked for the week of July 4th for vacation. Selectmen in agreement and she is to close the office for the week after advertising the fact in the Shopping Guide.
8. Job-Corp.Program: Person to work with Gordon 6 hours per week. Corp people would like 26 hours per week. Charlene to call them on Tuesday advising them of the fact and suggest they try to do other towns to make up the 26 hours.
9. MOTION MADE AND SECONDED TO AUTHORIZE CHARLENE HUMPHREY TO ARRANGE A TAX ANTICIPATION LOAD WITH FLEET BANK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,000. VOTE 3-0.
10. Letter signed to the above affect.
11. Recycling Committee to meet June 16th. Selectmen will attend.
12. Letter read from Ken Leavitt regarding a special Town Meeting. Vinal will attend Planning Board Meeting on June 2, to see when they would like to hold a special Town Meeting.
13. Letter from DEP for any interest in the program from waste water construction program. Grant money is available. Grants to already established waste water treatment plants. One addresses the special needs of a Town. Cornish rates #2 on the list Monies are available for 100% of the program outside of the land. Possible monies available

for the purchase of land. There will be a hearing in Augusta June 24, 1992 at 1 P.M. Don Jack will try to attend.

14. Richard Flewelling of MMA wrote re Snowplowing Contract. States the Selectmen acted properly with the way the Contract was handled.

15. Carlton spoke with MMA regarding Insurance coverage. They are going to furnish him with information.

16. Don regarding Roads in question: Old County Road, Pease Road and he will check with the Registry and call MMA for there opinion as to whether any legal action should be taken.

17. Norm Pratt asked that the Memorial Day program be turned over to the Veteran's.

18. R. Sanborn: Satellite dish is gone.
