C.A.B.-CORNISH ASSOCIATION OF BUSINESSES
HAD TWO LETTER FOR SELECTMEN.

ONE WAS AN INVITATION. C.A.B. WILL HAVE A PROGRAM ON THE Y2K.
THEY WILL HAVE BOB BOLEN OF THE YORK COUNTY EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT AGENCY COME AND SPEAK. ANY OR ALL OF THE
SELECTMEN ARE INVITED TO THE MEETING.

THEY HAVE ALSO INVITED THE CORNISH FIRE DEPARTMENT, SACOPEE
VALLEY HEALTH CENTER, AND THE SACOPEE RESCUE UNIT TO SEE IF WE
COULD WORK TOGETHER AS A COMMUNITY ON Y2K.

C.A.B. ALSO HAVE SOME ISSUES THAT THEY ARE CONCERNED ABOUT.
THEY ARE HOPING, THE C.A.B. MEMBERS AND THE SELECTMEN CAN WORK
ON THE ISSUES TOGETHER.

PUBLIC RESTROOMS.

THEY ASKED ABOUT GRANTS TO APPLY FOR. THE TOWN DID APPLY FOR
A GRANT BUT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL.

MEREDITH HARDING, THE CLARKS, NAN GURLEY, LISA CARBONI,
THE MCCURBERYS, THEY ALL ARE OPPOSED TO THE POLE LINES BEING
MOVED ACROSS THEIR PROPERTIES.

CROSSWALKS:

C.A.B. NEEDS TO TELL THE SELECTMEN WHERE THEY WANT THE
CROSSWALKS TO GO. THEY WERE PUT WHERE THEY THOUGHT THE MOST
FLOW WOULD BE. IF YOU WANT ADDITIONAL ONES LET THE SELECTMEN
KNOW.

D.O.T. SAYS BE AWARE OF TWO MANY CROSSWALKS.

C.A.B. ASKED IF THERE WAS A RULE OF THUMB AS FAR AS SPACING ON
CROSSWALKS, IF THERE WAS A NUMBER OF FEET, ETC.

D.O.T. SUGGESTED THAT FROM 5 TO 5 THERE SHOULD BE NO MORE THAN
5 CROSSWALKS AND THAT WOULD BE BUSY FOR THAT AMOUNT OF AREA.

C.A.B. WANTED TO KNOW WHEN THE ROAD CONSTRUCTION WAS DONE
WOULD THE CROSSWALKS BE DONE IN A DIFFERENT MATERIAL OR WILL
THEY JUST BE PAINTED LIKE THEY ARE NOW. IT IS STILL IN DISCUSSION
WITH D.O.T..

ANOTHER THING D.O.T. IS WORKING ON AND WILL BE PART OF THE
PROJECT, BUT DO NOT KNOW TO WHAT EXTENT. THERE WILL BE SOME
MOVEMENT OF THE TELEPHONE POLES AND LIGHT POLES UP THROUGH
THE VILLAGE. WHEN THEY DO THAT THEY WILL BE RECONFIGURING THE
WIRES SO THAT YOU WON'T SEE MANY GROUPINGS. IT WON'T LOOK AS
BAD AS IT DOES NOW. VINAL SEEM TO THINK THAT THERE WOULD BE A
CUTBACK IN THE NUMBER OF SOME POLES. TWO ARE BEING REMOVED
COMPLETELY.

SOME WIRES MIGHT GO HIGHER AND GROUPED TOGETHER TO NEATEN IT UP.

CARLTON COMMENTED ON THE PUBLIC RESTROOM ISSUE.
HE ASKED HOW MUCH WOULD IT COST TO LET SOMEONE USE YOUR
RESTROOMS? THERE ARE SOME PEOPLE SENDING PATRONS TO THE
TOWN HALL.

C.A.B. BROUGHT UP THAT SOME BUSINESSES ARE LIMITED TO THE
NUMBER OF USES.

THERE IS NO PUBLIC PLACE TO SEND THE GENERAL PUBLIC. MOST
BUSINESSES HAVE FOR CUSTOMERS ONLY SIGNS FOR THE RESTROOMS.

C.A.B. IS ADDRESSING THIS ISSUE BECAUSE THEY ARE TRYING TO
GENERATE A FLOW OF TRAFFIC, NOT OF CARS OF PEOPLE.

C.A.B. SEEMS TO THINK IT WOULD BE IN THE TOWNS BEST INTEREST TO
HAVE A PUBLIC RESTROOM.

THEN IT WAS BROUGHT UP THAT THE TOWN SHOULD HAVE A
CROSSWALK BY THE JEWELRY STORE. IT IS A VERY HAZARDOUS AREA.

IF CORNISH HAD PUBLIC BATHROOMS.

WE HAVE YOUR PROPOSAL, DO YOU HAVE A RESOLUTION?

A POSSIBILITY FOR A GRANT. SOME HOW TO FIND OUT HOW TO ALLOCATE
SOME MONEY.
