JUNE 17th, 1998


PRESENT: Carlton Candage, Vinal Pendexter, William Pease


Meeting called to order 6:55 PM. By Carlton Candage.

- 1.) Minutes of June 3, 1998 meeting read and accepted. Correction of May minutes read & signed. June 17th warrant read, accepted and signed.
- 2.) Ronald Othuse from Cornish Fire Dept. reports that the new radio system is complete. Limerick, Limington and Newfield are on line with them. They will try to include S. Hiram and Kezar Falls for communications during emergencies. Mr. Othuse asks that he not be bypassed in discussions regarding Fire Dept. matters. Carlton Candage suggests that Cornish Fire Dept. be involved with Grant writing.
- 3.) Ray Estabrook (CEO) states that there has been a threat of legal action from Paul Smith regarding property on corner of King & Maple St. He disputes the legality of his property as an "Historical Building" and has started an enclosed porch with no building permit. CEO has double checked the written codes and historical zoning. Certified letter has been sent out. No approval from the Planning Board has been sought. Stop Work order has been issued. A call this day to owner produced statement from owner that the house was not in Historical District. Selectmen recommend putting on next meeting agenda to see what action has been taken at such time.
- 4.) Question posed about cleaning up Hayes property. Deeded ownership still in question. William Pease will call registry for any copies next A.M. Carlton Candage gives maps to Ray Estabrook to review.
- 5.) Bills from F.R. Carroll given to Vinal Pendexter to forward on to W.L. Sturgeons Inc.
- 6.) Bill for contract on copier given to secretary to see if Danka will negotiate price. There were a high number of copies we didnt get due to copier not working correctly.
- 7.) Letter read from Sacopee Rescue regarding meeting for June 22 at 7:00 PM in regards to new building plans.
- 8.) Abatements read, reviewed and signed.

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- 9.) John Love requested a review of his property tax. Finished room above garage and other property amenities were not included in original assessment so the assessment is under value not over as Mr. Love suggests.
- 10) Carlton Candage has found someone from Lovell to do the striping downtown for \$100.00 when the weather breaks.
- 11) Carlton wants TRIO called regarding billing.
- 12) Vinal Pendexter asked to assess Calls property. Carlton will work on rest of assessment and transfers next Tues. Selectmen are to get together Wed. to finish transfers and assessments.
- 13) Town Leach field has been cleaned and bamboo cleared.
- 14) Bob Libby has the sign for Cornish Business Park and will be putting up in AM.
- 15) Motion made to adjourn. Motion Seconded. Meeting adjourned 8:00 PM.
