SELECTMEN'S MEETING - june 22, 1987

Present: Warren Neal; Bonite Ouellette; Ronald Othuse

- 1) County Commissioners viewed Richard Taylor property. Richard maintains Town owns 1 acre of land that belongs to him. On August 26, 1986 the Selectmen's Meeting Minutes read "Jim agrees that we accept Wilfred Taylor's decision stand on the non-conforming lot and it be between R. Taylor and Cemetery Assoc." MOTION made that we go by the decision made on 8/26/86. Seconded. VOTE.
- 2) Gun Permit for Danny Day signed.
- 3) Taxes to be audited 6/30/87.
- 4) Eva Lord Property complication. Bud Runyon called wanted to know what names were on the deed. Inasmuch as a Quit-Claim deed should have been issued instead of Warranty Deed. To issue a Warranty Deed requires vote of Town.
- 5) David Birchfield; Sewer Project - call engineer and have him come up 6/27/87.
- 6) Sturgeons cleaned out ditch and culvert at Stephen DiBiasco's on the High Road. All the tile Stephen put in was destroyed. Need 18" culvert to replace the smaller culvert Stephen had put in. Stephen will buy the piece of 18" culvert.
- 7) Light in park is broken MOTION made that the Park Light be repaired. Seconded VOTE.
- 8) Joanne Lancaster (County Commissioner) wants to know if all Ordinance voted on by the Town are in one Place. They should be all together and notarized by Town Clerk. (They are now all together).
- 9) Beverly & Ezmund Day - June 17th Court hearing, if clean-up was not done. July 15th new Court date.
- 10) Animal Control Officer: Kathleen Johnson, Cornish; Leif Larson, Cornish; Linda Walker, Sebago are candidates. MOTION made that Kathleen Johnson be appointed Dog Control Officer. Seconded. VOTE. Mrs. Johnson notified 6/23/87.
- 11) Mr. Solomon would like to put a 40 unit Mobile Home Park on Route 5, catering to the elderly.
- 12) Dump: SRCC voted down the application. Talk is of removing the support by Towns from the Commission.
- 13) Mr. Oliver: Town taking over road down to his house. Road has to meet special standards. Requires vote of Town. Ronnie thought the Town would not be in favor.
- 14) Stan Sargent; Would like Speed limit Signs posted on Circle Drive. DOT Div. 6 must receive request for stop signs at end of road, as they are responsible. Also Children Playing signs to be posted.

15) Dump: No alternative site in mind. Meet Wednesday to consider reappealing decision by SRCC. Must decide whether to go door to door. Have David Jordan or someone truck direct to MeRCK. Other four towns would go along with door to door pick-up. price of transfer station will go up every year. Warren feels we should break inter-local agreement and go on our own. The three Selectmen could speak with d. Jordan and ask how much he would charge to pick up the entire town.

Water Company: nothing final as yet. Legislation runs out July 1, 1987.
