Selectmen's Meeting
June 23, 1980

Present: Hoxie, Ronnie, Dr. DiBiaso, Marcia

I. Shanon Nee requests rental of Town Hall on July 4th for a dance. Doc to get back to them tomorrow with a letter stating the following:

- 1) proper security consisting of 2 uniformed police officers plus 3 assistant control officers;
- 2) because of likelihood of minors to attend, no alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the Hall;
- 3) \$60 rental fee plus \$60 security deposit. Deposit will be returned afterwards if there are no damages. If there are any damages, they must pay for repair costs;
- 4) they must clean up Hall and grounds afterwards.

Two copies, one for them and one for our files.

II. Bicentennial Committee suggested donation of new metal folding chairs. Doc asking feedback from Ronnie and Hoxie: Doc made suggestion of contacting Bi-cent. Comm. and asking them to reconsider the spending of this money for chairs, and instead putting the money toward insulating parts of Town Hall, storm windows, and storm doors. Possibly, if the chairs have been ordered, to consider cancelling the order. If this is unexceptable to the Comm. then we will accept the chairs. Doc to contact the Comm. and to report back to Board next meeting.

III. Members to Southern Maine Regional Planning Commission Robert Pike has resigned; Sam Hoyt has also resigned, therefor leaving two vacant spots. Bill is asking for possible replacement/ suggestions.

IV. Lillian Sturgeon called Bill with two complaints: Shaw's dog being unleashed and out of control--Bill to contact David Elliott; Manure pile at shaw's is a public neisence--Doc to see them.

V. Bill brought up the issue of the Planning Board's lackness in service, and he's suggested writing each member a letter inquiring of their interest to continue to serve. Ronnie and Doc were in agreeance.

VI. Bill received answer from Regional Waste System--they are accepting no applications untill 1981.
