Dan Sherman came in to get zoning clarification on the old C.N. Brown station and the land behind Heli Modified.


The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrants were signed.


Bud Runyon had left a quick-claim deed for Howard Saturley on the door. The selectmen need verification on paid taxes before they can sign it.
