

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - June 3, 1985

The following items were discussed -

TOWN MAPS: William Colby, who worked for Ray O'Donald will do the maps for less. He will send the originals and they will be put in safe. Cost??

Registry of Deeds states that their copies of our Town maps are used so much and need to be replaced.

WEEKS DEED: Florence Weeks feels the Town should pay for the work and Don told her to consult a lawyer.

WATER COMPANY: Don has not gotten in touch with Howard Saturley, and hasn't got the copies as yet. Dr. DiBiasco voted to get what is needed for 1980, 81, 82, 83 and 84 and this will give the Town all the information needed to date on the Water Company.

ROADS: There is a dip in the road at the end of Fiddle Lane that was dug by the Water Co. when they repaired the hydrant, this should be repaired and the bill sent to the Water Co. Also a repair needs to be done by Cahills. Sturgeon to repair road by school.

Road Commissioner should clean up sand at Koenig's house. If Sturgeon won't do it, then Gordon was going to. Also Freddie Hayes might do it.

DOG COMPLAINTS: Freddie has a dog which he says he is going to keep.

EVA LORD: Don will see her about the stove. Dr. Marston states the stove was to be given to him - Jim feels it should stay in the house. Nothing of value in house, refridgerator, bureau. The minutes stand - this property was supposed to stay as it is while Eva was alive.

ASSESSORS: Don and Jim have been doing assessing. Ratio has dropped to low 70's due to FHA and Maine State Housing financing low interest rates of less than 10%.
