PRESENT: Carlton Candage, Vinal Pendexter, William Pease


Meeting called to order by Carlton Candage 7:00 PM

- 1.) Reese Cushman has taken a course and discusses role of Animal Control Officer and items he would like to see implemented. He will look into price of Rabies shots etc.
- 2.) Minutes from last meeting read. Correction to be made regarding vote of Planning Board Officers. (All were not in favor). Warrant reviewed, accepted and signed.
- 3.) Selectmen request a notice in Shopping Guide for A.C.O. also a notice for someone to serve on Appeals Board.
- 4.) Ronald Othuse would like to have an evening meeting with Bob Bowman and C.F.D. and Selectmen for Emergency Plans and to look into cellular phones, hazardous spills etc.
- 5.) Pole Permit signed.
- 6.) School Budget, School District meeting discussed.
- 7.) Contract from Trio reviewed and compared to original proposal. Rob needs to be asked about difference in figures before contract will be signed.
- 8.) John Cleveland requests more money from CDBG for Bus. Park. Request from Gorham Sand & Gravel will not be paid until mulching and seeding/cleaning are done. Some monies will be held till result of seeding shows. CFD would like to see the water hydrant lifted up. Selectmen recommend that \$1,000. of money be held till seeding is satisfactory.
- 9.) Update of Sand & Salt Contract. Bid for Downtown Sewerage project to be put in Shoppers Guide.
- 10.) Transfers need to be done. Decision made to give commercial properties to Vinal. Carlton will work on transfers next Tues.
- 11.) Fairgrounds Committee want Selectmen to approve amendments to their by-laws before Special Town Meeting.
- 12.) Carlton will see Bobby regarding sign at Business Park.
- 13.) Carlton has called Zebra striping and they have not called back. He will call again following day.


