

Selectmen's Meeting June 5, 2009

Vinal Pendexter and Peggi Aspinall were present for the meeting.

Warrants and Minutes signed.

Tiffany Parent requests selectmen's approval to use of the 2nd floor of the Odd Fellows Hall to house the Cornish Historical Society. Selectmen requested she be invited to the next meeting to discuss her expectations of use.

Selectmen tabled a request by Stephanie Glatzer to use Pike Memorial Hall for a 6 week Summer and a Fall/Winter aerobic session until all selectmen were present to discuss it.

Motion made to approve the Cornish School and Alumni Association's use of the Fire Barn on June 27th for a fundraiser and to hold the monthly meetings there as well. The group will be asked to use the small room for their meetings. Seconded and Approved.

Central Maine Power requests the Town pay an additional \$8.36 a month plus energy for a pole that was inadvertently missed in the town's inventory. The pole may be removed if the selectmen want. Motion made to table a decision until Vinal reviews the location of the pole. Seconded and approved.

Three names were submitted for nomination to the School's District Planning Committee. Motion made to nominate Rich Ruhlin and Lee Goldsberry. Seconded. The vote was one for and one against. Motion made to nominate Rich Ruhlin and the other nominee to be selected at the 6/17 selectman's meeting. Seconded and approved.

Liquor license renewal signed for the Sacopee House of Pizza.

Special Town Meeting Warrants for the Comprehensive Plan's Goals and Objectives were signed. The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 18th at 6:30 p.m.

Selectmen were informed that the Vision Appraisal and Harris Computer annual maintenance fees increased over the budgeted amount. The monies will be taken out of Contingency.

Peggi stopped to talk with Joe Foley about the "Welcome to Cornish" sign on his property. Joe Foley does not want the sign any closer to his house. Peggi offered an alternate site for the sign near Tim Stone's property and Vinal will take a look.


A background check for a Concealed Weapon Permit was signed.

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Moulton Lumber submitted two bids for shingles for the roof (Pike Hall); 30-year shingles \$7,241.00 and lifetime shingles \$9,287.00. Vinal has another bid coming for materials only from BRD Wholesale Roofers in Lewiston, Maine. He expects a 10% reduction in cost and an additional benefit they are able to place the shingles on the roof when they deliver provided the roof has already been stripped.

The Animal Control Officer contacted Vinal for a course of action regarding a stray cat that was ill. Vinal instructed the ACO to take the cat to Sacopee Vets for an evaluation and call with results. Vinal has not heard back from ACO or Sacopee Veterinary. He asked that thought be given to draft a procedure to follow for future incidents.
