

The following items were discussed:

1. Scott Perry requested Hazard signs placed on the Roland Day Road, due to accident that occurred there recently. Selectmen agree to posting signs.
2. Performance Bond for Robert Sturgeon signed.
3. Trailer at park, belonging to Metcalf's Trading Post, has been removed, the next one must be parked elsewhere.
4. Tree Pruning - Danny Day can do this if Freddie is unavailable. What will he charge to do this?
5. Recreation Program - There are 28 children from Cornish attending. Linda Stetser asked if some funds could be obtained from the Town of Cornish. They are asking \$150 - \$100 recommended by Selectmen. Next year, if they want the funds, they are to get it in the form of an Article and place it in Warrant.
6. Maine Comm. Block Grant - Don will see if we qualify to purchase Water Company.
7. 1983 Report of the Water Co. is available
8. S. D. Warren Sludge for fertilizer, used at Pike's.
9. Patch Sidewalks from Flower Wagon to Haines Gibson's. Cost of repairing downtown was \$120. The Water Company should reimburse the town. Holes in parking area should be filled in. Approval of the owner should be received before Town does the patching.
10. According to the Auditor the discount for early payment of taxes, which was an oversight and left out of the Warrant, should be included in a Special Town Meeting, when it is held, if not, be sure it is on the 1985 Town Warrant.
11. Invitation to Maine Energy Recovery Co. on 7/19/85. No one interested in going.
12. Eva Lord House: Dr. Marston picked up the stove last week, plus stove piping and asbestos.
13. Sign needed for Handicapped parking.
14. Signs for entrance to Cornish - Barr is supposed to come and look at it.
15. There is a broken bench in the park. Also get Maurice Gammon to put "Welcome to Cornish" signs up.
16. Notice put in Shoppers Guide in re "Horses on Sidewalks and parking on sidewalks.
