
A check was received from the state FEMA for snowplowing relief in the amount of \$2010.06. Carlton wants in deposited in the Roads and Bridges account.


Peter Ouellette and Dan Vaillancourt made a request to be on the Planning Board. Carlton will talk to Dan Sherman to set up interviews.


The Planning Board made a request that they receive a copy of the law that states that the selectmen can extend a liquor license with ^{DPH}planning board involvement.
