- (1) No one showed to protest the liquor license for Stone Ridge Rest. No application to sign. Selectmen will sign it on Tuesday.
- (2) Water Company meeting on Tuesday evening. Howard Saturley will try to make the meeting. Ray Hammon will be at the meeting on the 13th.
- (3) There is a problem with the lot at U1-14D. Dr. owns it, Don needs book and page number.
- (4) Monday, August 5th, there will be a meeting with DEP and S.. D. Warren in regards to discuss S. D. Warren sludge which is being used as fertilizer.
- (5) DEP called regarding sewerage that goes directly into the Ossipee River and Little River. There is money available for a sewage system.
- (6) Steps will be done at the Town Hall. The Hall is rented for the 3rd and 10th.
- (7) Mr. Parker, who has purchased the old drug store, has a couple of boxes of drug store left-overs and is going to take them to the dump. He has been advised that he should check and make sure they won't harm water, etc. and be sure nothing is of a hazardous nature. Motion made seconded. VOTE.

- (11) Liability Ins. coming from Pike, Lovejoy.
- (12) Letter received from Attorney Runyon re Florence Weeks taxes.
