

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

July 6, 1987

Present: W. Neal; R. Othuse; B. Ouellette

- 1) Don Jack was heard regarding the Dump. SRCC to be asked to reconsider vote. Will go to Court to appeal. Meanwhile looking for another site. SRCC will not appeal due to the fact there has been a public hearing. They spoke of article in Guide. Don did not vote in favor of the Dump, because of conflict of interest. Bonnie feels that with all the work that has been done, each of the Towns should have voted for it. In order to appeal, someone from a town that voted against it will have to go and ask for an Appeal. Would Mary, as a "NO" voter and as a citizen of Cornish ask for an Appeal?
- 2) Town Meeting: July 13, 1987. Bill Hoxir voted to be Moderator.
- 3) Bob Jameson: Re doing the Maps, there were problems and some errors. All error corrected and Maps are now correct. \$450 appropriated. \$17.50 for the small ones. \$2500 voted for updating the Zoning Maps.
- 4) Mr. Solomon called about children playing. Land owner or Town responsible for erecting "Children Playing signs"? If the States says the Town will have to put them up, then we are responsible. Captain Cody of the Sanford Police Department sells them. Walter Stickney has requested speed limit signs on the High Road. He must notify the Selectmen in writing. Lillian Sturgeon, both Theresa and Bobby say the stop sign on the street was an agreement made with Walter Rines when he had his store. MOTION: Made and seconded that the "No Parking" sign be put up. VOTE. 2-1 (Bonnie against).
- 5) Gordon Hall: Warren will call. We have to contact Bud Runyon, the deed to be ready and delivered to Charlene tonight.
- 6) Water Company: Purchased on June 30, 1987. Warren to draft letter to Trustees re: no contact between Selectmen; publish meetings; and to provide Town with copy of deeds, ets.
- 7) Mike Rogers, the Tax Man, here regarding tax audit. We can raise our taxes by 20% across the board and still be legal. All okay. Still working on taxes, Tuesday P.M. Bonnie & Warren will meet to work some more.
- 8) Charlene asked about purchasing metal shelves for license plates. Agreed.
- 9) Ronnie will write for speed signs for Circle Drive.
