

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
AUGUST 8, 2001**

Frank Sanborn and David Whitney came in while the snow plow bids were opened. Frank's was \$92,000.00. David Whitney and Chip Howard's bid was \$77,550.00.

Vinal made a motion to go into executive session.

The snowplow contract was awarded to David Whitney and Chip Howard.

The minutes from the last meeting was signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrants were signed.

The selectmen signed a URIP form that is MDOT's form to release money to the town for revenue sharing.

There was a discussion on Peter Campbell's and The Paint Wizard's bid for painting the Town Hall. Carlton will negotiate getting the building and the trim done this year and the windows done next year.

The Town of York sent all the towns in York County a letter to withhold York County taxes due to costly effective services. Carlton expressed some concern that if not paid by due date that there is a penalty fee. Carlton made a motion to table it until better understanding of the due date of the taxes. Vinal seconded the motion.

Richard Russell's lease was received. His Portion was raised from \$19.00 to \$75.00 per month. There was a discussion on the fact that the building needs to be inspected. The lease was signed. Carol needs to make a copy of it for the files and the original mailed out.

Carlton asked Vinal about reevaluation. Vinal is going to talk to David Sawyer to see if he can do it.

There was a discussion on the need for new people for the fair ground committee.

Carol asked for a raise since she had now been here for a year. Carlton said that was discussed before and that she needed to look up in the minutes for the conditions and bring it up at the next meeting. The minutes were looked up and it wasn't mentioned. Carol thinks she remembers that it had to do with the registration problems that the town office is having.
