The following items were discussed:

- 1. The Highland Jersey Farm evaluation mistake goes back to 1981. It has been corrected this year on the tax bill.
- 2. Ethel Sargent is interested in Eva Lord's wood. The Selectmen agreed with Eva to leave things as they are.
- 3. Dr. DiBiaso sroke about the morument in the park. The monument needs to be set up on a base 14-16" high and landscaped, this will be done when sidewalks are done. Light in the park needs repairs and Lloyd Sargent has ordered them. Trees also need to be pruned.
- 4. Nothing heard from Eliz. Birchfield regarding paving of the jointly used parking lot.
- 5. \$400 to remove tree at Ina Day's.
- 6. Front steps to be finished off before check is disbursed.
- 7. Howard Saturley reports that the town wells are low. He would like the Town to publish notice in Shopping Guide, Selectmen feel it is up to Howard to do this.
- 8. Parking on Sidewalks still not in paper. Don Jack feels personal contact would make for better feelings where we don't have a law enforcement officer.
- 9. There has been a complaint about the Co-Hi Orchard sign at Route 5 & 25, obstructs view. Village limits are the Selectmen's responsibility
- 10. Letter received from York County Home Care Services asking for the \$240 appropriated at Town Meeting. Letter to advise them that the tax bills are going out and they will be paid as soon as taxes come in.
- 11. Phil Day Salt Shed. Will pav after Town Meeting as they agreed. Weed snray is by the garage. It should be put in the basement of the Town Hall.
- 12. The sign by LeTarte's is the only "Welcome To Cornish" sign standing. There are three signs in the Town Hall. Cliff Whitney doesn't know when or if he can paint them.
- 13. DEP and Sewage asked for violators. Saco River Corridor to give the list to them.
- 14. General Liability Ins. Pol. received from Lovejoy.
- 15. Tax rate will remain the same as Ist year at 19 ml.
