The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrants were signed.

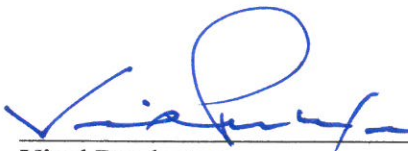
An anonymous e-mail was received about the trash situation. Vinal made a motion and John seconded the motion to file it with no action.
