

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
AUGUST 21, 2002**

Jim and Regina Robinson came in to talk about turning the old corn shop building into a place of residence. Jim has gotten a septic design and plot plan. Carlton will get legal council to get clarification on usage since the property changed hands after a demolition permit was issued.

Rob Millard came in to find out the status of the Day – Jordan fence dispute. Rob will talk to Day's lawyer and the Jordan's for further clarification of the dispute.

The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable from August 7<sup>th</sup> and the accounts payable warrant for August 21<sup>st</sup> were signed. The payroll warrant was signed.

The selectmen signed an application for games of chance license.

A proposal from Dodge Oil was received for the town account that was \$.10 less than last year.

The millpond dam is under Cliff Whitney's control. A copy of the deed is needed to contest dam control.

A quote was received for \$700.00 for a new salt/sand shed – recycling sign. It would be one sided and at an angle to the road. Vinal thinks the sign should be two sided and at a 90 degree angle to the road so it can be read from both directions. Carlton will get a new price for the sign.
