1.) Town Meeting preparations

A. Options:

1. stay with Normantas for the additional \$3800
2. landfill--hire soil scientist for survey of possible sites and engineering studies would be necessary
3. Transfer station--look into site selection/acquisition; contract to haul; and locate a disposal site (landfill or incineration)
4. Incineration--landfill
