August 23, 2000

Selectmen read and signed minutes from last meeting and also the warrants.

Diane Perkins is concerned about County Rd and the Piccininni's gate closing the road. Vinal has also heard several complaints concerning the gate. When Diane was on the Planning Board she obtained county maps on road placement. The selectmen will have to have copies before anything can be done.

Pole permits for Thompson St. were signed.

MDOT funding papers were signed.

Discussions were made concerning the egresses on the development of the new Bangor Savings Bank and other buildings on to Rt. 25. The planning board will wait for contact from the MDOT.

Discussions were made concerning the entrance to the Business Park that will require further thought and discussion.

A letter was discussed from the school to sign off on local allocation of dept. service on Adult Education. Selectmen will hold off until they send back calculation on how the amount is arrived.

Selectmen passed on invitation to a school building inspection of all district schools.

A motion was made to go into executive session.

A letter from Energy Atlantic for lower power rates for municipalities was discussed. It was decided to wait until other companies submit proposals.


A discussion inside about cell towers concerns and responsibilities.


The need to bring the office up to compliance was discussed. Fireproof files are needed. Research will be done on prices.
