

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - August 3, 1987

- 1) Call O'Donald re changes on maps - Warren.
- 2) Jack Kelley here to discuss happenings on Planning Board. Example: Pendexter property on Route 25, he feels that "hanky panky" has gone on the way the Building permit and power permits were issued. Vinal did not present a deed to property. "Non-conforming" lot should go to Board of Appeals. Other violations. He feels that everyone has taken oath to enforce the ordinances and if not complying, should resign. Jack feels that both Marilyn and Vinal should be asked to resign from Planning Board. Jack asked David to rescind the power permit, but David refused. If the selectmen do not take action to take matter under advisement and decide what should be done. Historically the Board of Appeals have met only 2 - 3 times. At this time we do not have a Board of Appeals and haven't since May. Warren has had a lengthy discussion with David and David felt it was his authority to take care of power permits. He knows the P.B. should sign them. Selectmen may remove anyone from P.H. with a public hearing. This will be taken under advisement until the next Selectmen's meeting.
- 3) John Hoyt and Maurice Ouellette here asking where they stand on the subdivision. Waiting for them to apply for a permit. It is now in the hands of the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 4) Letter received from County Commissioners re Richard Taylor abatement - not granted.
- 5) Commissioner of Education - \$6,300,000 in block grants - prorated on per pupil basis. Cornish will receive \$7,549.75 to be used in tax committment.
- 6) Day matter; Bonnie reported that the property has been checked and they are making progress, still not totally satisfied. One week continuation and if they are making progress will stop the Court date of August 17.
- 7) Cost of storm windows - out of balance of Fed. Rev. Sharing. (\$1,57.58)
Appro. \$3,000 for Gen. Maintenance
- 8) Noise in neighborhood - Warren has written State Police and they will patrol more.
- 9) Ronnie attended the SRCC meeting. They refused to reconsider the negative vote. Dump committee made half-hearted attempt to appeal. Warren asked if it would help if Selectmen decided to do something on their own - Ronnie said wait a week.
- 10) Steve Farrar and David met and will send information to Selectmen.
- 11) Gun permits signed; Brent Nelson, passed. Kelley Meggison, tabled.
- 12) Board of Appeals appointed

Connie Forbes - 4 year term
Daniel Day - 4 year term
Donald White - 3 year term
Nathlene Watson - 3 year term.
