- 1) Two gun permits signed - K. Meggison & P. Kilburn.
- 2) Minutes of last meeting read and signed.
- 3) Hearing on Stone Ridge liquor license delayed until 8 p.m.
(License approved) Class I License, on premises consumption.'
- 4) The cars at Jeffrey Carpenters are still on sidewalk. Lillian Bell has cleared her driveway. These things must be followed up with action. Contact the State Police to notify them.
- 5) Town acquired property R8 Lot 57. There is interest in this property. We should sell it to get back some of the taxes. Advertised in Shopping Guide, posted four places and sealed bids.
- 6) Solid Waste: Discussion was held regarding the recent meeting held between the five towns and Newfield regarding pick-up of solid waste. All towns have suffered an increase in cost Normantus, and have not budgeted or appropriated the money for such an increase. Motion made: We pay Luidas Normantus the amount as billed. Agreed. VOTE.

- 11) Richard Taylor: In regard to 2 acres, more or less of land purchased from Cemetery Assoc. that seems to belong to the town. Mix-up at Eva Lord's. Bill Taylor is surveying the property for the Town, once this is completed and when Saturley's land is surveyed for the Water Co., it will all fall into place. Richard wanted to know if the Selectmen would meet with Bud Runyon, agreed.
- 12) Appointments to Planning Board: Selectmen appointed:
