Selectmen's Meeting September 12, 2011

Vinal Pendexter, Margaret Aspinall and Nancy Perkins were present for the meeting.

Calista Cross met with selectmen at their request to discuss her campaign with DOT to have the speed limit signs entering and exiting town repositioned further down (south) on Route 5 or have the speed limit reduced. DOT told her a request must come through the selectmen's office. Vinal stated his observations: road is in good condition, there's safe site distance; no sharp curves or blind spots, it has a pedestrian walk way and he cannot recall any accident there due to speed. Nancy will invite Brian Keezer to visit the town and make a determination.

Calista has scheduled Colton Sweeney and the inmates scheduled to do trash clean up along Route 5. Selectmen told Calista any project for the inmates needs to be coordinated through the town office. We have projects earmarked as well.

Minutes and warrants reviewed and signed.

Motion made to approve Cornish Historical Society's request to use the basement of Pike Memorial Hall on Tuesday, September 20th at 7 p.m. Seconded and approved.

Our ACO asked selectmen's approval to attend a 5-day conference being offered in Augusta. The expenses will be shared amongst the 5 towns she covers. Selectmen asked that the details be available for our next meeting.

Selectmen reviewed the heating fuel bids from Pitstop @ \$3.349, Lampron @ \$3.20 (OPIS + .07/gal), CN Brown \$3.377(estimated), JP Carroll\$3.599 and Dodge. Nancy will speak with CN Brown to see if they will match Pitstop's price. If they will match the price the town selects CN Brown, if they do not the selectmen will continue to watch fuel prices.

Nancy researched a contact in Augusta regarding the adoption procedure of the Shoreland Zoning maps for the planning board.

Nancy relayed questions she'd like answered after reviewing the new property and casualty policy. To date we have not received the bonds that were requested. Vinal will get answers from Scott Lovejoy for our next meeting.

2011 Municipal Property Tax Levy Limit Survey will be passed to Diane Harrington to be completed.
