

## Selectmen's Meeting September 13, 2006

Vinal Pendexter, John Palmer, and Peggi Aspinall were present for the meeting.

Accounts payable and payroll warrants reviewed and approved along with the minutes from meeting on August 30th.

A quitclaim deed for 2003 tax lien (U03-015) recorded in Book 14159, Page 875 on July 19, 2004 was signed by the selectmen.

30 day notice for running an illegal junkyard at R01-011 was signed by the selectmen and code enforcement officer.

Municipal Tax Assessment Warrant for 2006 was signed by the selectmen.

The Animal Control Officers submitted a report of their findings regarding a complaint received several weeks ago that had been brought to the selectmen through a second party. The selectmen determined that there was nothing they had an issue with and a motion to table the complaint was made and seconded by all.

Notice of deadline requiring filing of proofs of claim on or before May 6<sup>th</sup> against Adelpia Corporation bankruptcy. No claims are pending as far as the selectmen know. A motion was made not to act on it. Seconded and approved.

A customer evaluation survey by Vision Appraisal was completed by the selectmen.

Selectmen agreed on Sunday, Sept. 17th to meet to begin the abatement review process. Corrective changes to the assessment for R. Sturgeon's Fieldstone development and how to accomplish it were discussed.

Peggi Aspinall initiated a discussion of any possible alternatives available to the Town in the event a sex offender would try to locate in Cornish. The selectmen decided they needed to contact MMA to find out what the Town's rights are. Peggi stated that if we do have right to do something, we should do it to protect the kids.


Motion made to go into Executive Session to discuss application for Concealed Weapon. Seconded.
