I. Eva Lord is requesting 9 tons of coal. Eva also mentioned to Doc that Richard Taylor has been trying to get her to sign off a right of way, and Doc told her not to sign anything. She wouldn't have any right signing off this right of way anyway because the town owns the property.

II. Snow Removal Bids: the deadline for receiving bids was tonight by 8:00 P.M. Theresa Sturgeon presented her bid. Voting will have to wait until Bill's return since Ronnie does not vote on this due to conflict of interest (He works for Sturgeon).

III. There will be a dump meeting this thursday with the DEP and an engineer to go over Normantas's operation (Southern Maine Regional Planning Commission will pay for this)
