The minutes from the last meeting were signed. The accounts payable and the payroll warrant were signed.






An easement and pole permit thru the Business Park was received. The town owns the land and the selectmen want a map and compensation before they sign the permits.

There was a discussion about the new road signs needed since the naming of all roads for the 911 addressing. It was decided that they will wait for the finalized map for road names and the amount of signs needed. They will put an article in for town meeting for funds. They will also offer to let anyone with a private drive to buy their signs at the same time for town price.

Vinal said that he came to the town hall during a Planning Board workshop. Bob Harrisburg has applied for a permit to build another duplex house on his lot. Vinal was concerned that he hasn't complied with the clean up of the Co Hi building. He also looked at the lot size and it is not big enough to put on another duplex. The selectmen will go to the next Planning Board meeting to advise the ^M on this issue and the Morrill's gravel pit project.
