

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING
SEPTEMBER 20,2000**

The meeting was attended by Carlton Candage and Vinal Pendexter.

The minutes for the last meeting and the warrants were signed. There was a question on the refund of taxes to the Stewart Title, Co. (Monte Huwlyer). It was paid twice and needed to be refunded.

Ken Ridsdale came in to find out about the Animal Control Officers position. He agreed to accept the position. Carlton made a motion to hire him and Vinal seconded the motion.

The County Tax Assessor papers were signed.

It was decided to order a new fireproof file for the town office. This will help bring us up to compliance.

The MDOT is paying for a roadside maintenance and grading. They will pay \$100.00 for the piece in front of the Fire Co. and the piece by Thompson Park. The back page was missing for the Town Hall. Carlton will call Tom Linscott for the missing page.

Someone needs to be hired to clean the Town Hall. Carlton will talk to Patty about doing it; (She cleans the post office).

Carlton made a motion that the Town Hall not be rented out during the last two weeks of December and January due to rising fuel costs. It was decided that it would not be rented out unless they want to pay extra to cover the heat costs.

Vinal has been trying to get in touch with Sylvia Pease about the school parking problems. They put up their own signs and Vinal will find out if this problem seems to be solved with that.

George Carroll's open space tax discount was discussed. Vinal talked to David Sawyer from Gorham and Carol from Windham and they said you have to grant it to them. There is a penalty for removing it from open space. They have decided to recognize his application. Vinal will fill John in on the situation and have him talk to George Carroll about it.

Vinal will do Bobby Libby's reassessment after he gets the rest of the information he needs.

Grey Barns reassessment was completed.

Dennis Mowry's letters were signed Vinal has engaged a new attorney, David Brent, and he will call Dennis concerning the information he needs. Vinal will also call Dennis and ask him to attend a meeting to discuss other accounts that need to be straightened out.

The lease building monies need to be in a separate account. The money can be used for lot maintenance, but it has to be accountable. Charlene will set up this account.

The request for renting the Town Hall for an Adult Halloween Party was discussed. They can't rent it unless it is for a nonprofit organization. Charlene called them 9/22 and denied the request.

The street signs are missing at the Hessian Hill Rd. and Healy Rd. Vinal will get in touch with Bobby and get them reinstated, so that the Rescue Units can find their way around.

Carlton will call the Selectmen from the five towns affiliated with the Sacopee Rescue to discuss the nonresponse of the rescue unit.

Redlon Cope's problem about the evaluation was discussed. Carlton will get in touch with him.

Barbara Dubin called to find out if the Howe Rd. was discontinued. Its prescribed use was presumed abandoned not discontinued. Carlton will call her.

Vinal and Carlton will check on Thomas Grant's trailer on Rt. 5 to see if it needs revaluation.


Parker Appraisal will be invited to the next meeting to discuss town reassessment.

They will have Charlene set up abatements to be reviewed at the meetings.


The meeting was adjourned at 8:00
