

## **Selectmen's Meeting September 26, 2007**

Vinal Pendexter, Peggi Aspinall, and Nancy Perkins were present for the meeting.

Heli Modified owners Cindy and Harry Eddy and Patty and Tom Ingalls of their management staff discussed a proposed expansion of the current building in the Industrial Park. Cindy Eddy offered to contact a grant writer named Christine Owman of Waterboro.

David Whitney and selectmen signed the 2007-2008 Snow Plowing contract which includes an agreed upon fuel clause to item no.17 in the contract.

Nancy Perkins asked if Diane has been able to produce quarterly reports of the town budget. Diane explained that now that tax bills have been sent out she would work towards producing the reports.

Robert Millard requested reimbursement for his time attending court in the Roland Scott vs. the town. Selectmen approved the request.

The warrants for accounts payable and payroll along with the minutes from the last meeting were reviewed and approved. Vinal questioned the amount of mileage submitted for reimbursement by the animal control officer.

Jill Dehmer requested use of the fire barn for girl scouts on Monday nights and Heidi Cates would like to use the fire barn for boy scouts preceding Jill on the same Monday night. Selectmen discussed the frequency of use of the fire barn and decided to have the scouts meet in the first meeting room on the right and free up the main community room for other requests. Motion was made and seconded.

Selectmen set Wednesday night (10/3) to meet to review the real estate abatements submitted to date. Motion made to meet with James Carr at that meeting to discuss his abatement request. Seconded and approved.

The 2007 Municipal Valuation Return verifying the town's personal and real estate commitment was signed by the selectmen.

The 801 for Personal Property rebates for Pepsi Co and Bangor Savings were signed.

The variance letter for Mitchell/Ireland enclosed porch was reviewed and signed.

Reviewed details for the "Welcome to Cornish" signs being done by Laura Carr. Selectmen want the funds to be taken from Contingency.

Peggi Aspinall updated the selectmen on the School Consolidation Plan. The MSAD55 decision to stand alone was denied because the district is under the required 2500 student body. Districts were told to reapply with more detailed information for justification of their decision. Peggi will draft the letter to be submitted.

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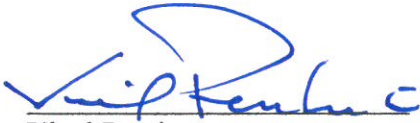

The Mill Pond project is waiting a call from the DEP regarding the project.

The York County Commissioners finding of facts were received regarding George Carroll's request for review of abatement done by the town. Discussion of findings followed. The town may fill out an ADB Appeal to the Superior Court.

Roland Scott's court date was 9/19. Roland represented himself and did not call himself as a witness so the town's lawyer could not cross-examine him. Judge is taking it under consideration and will make a determination.
